



## Day 1 - Arrival

<i>Dinner</i>	Depart via luxury coaches to a local restaurant for a casual 'Welcome Dinner'.

<i>Afternoon</i>	<p>Continue the visit of the “<b>Big Easy</b>” with a guided walking tour of the Historic French Quarter and Bourbon Street. The group will stop for coffees and beignets.</p> <p>Returning to the hotel, the group will prepare for dinner.</p>
<i>Dinner</i>	<p>Luxury motor coaches to a local restaurant for a classic ‘New Orleans’ dinner.</p>
<i>Evening Suggestion</i>	<p>After dinner evening in a Jazz Club</p>



## Day 3 – Plantation Tour



<i>Morning</i>	Full American Breakfast at the hotel (Private or on flow) Today's visit will focus on the <b>historic plantations</b> that are numerous in Louisiana and very singular to the area. The tour will guide the group through various plantations home.
<i>Lunch</i>	Following the walking tour, the group will enjoy a local and classic lunch on site.
<i>Afternoon</i>	After lunch, the group will continue its tour through the plantations of Louisiana.

*Lunch*

Just a short drive from **New Orleans** are a number of picturesque **Louisiana swamps** and a variety of tours that you can take to explore the endless waterways and breathtaking nature. You'll explore undeveloped reaches of Louisiana decorated with Spanish moss and lined with gnarled cypress trees. Along the way, you'll be sure to encounter swamp wildlife like alligators, hundreds of different species of birds and many other animals.



*Day 4 –  
Afternoon: Organization  
of a car race*



<p><i>Afternoon</i></p>	<p>In the afternoon, the group will go to a track, where a race will be organized with motor race cars. The group will participate in the race if they wish and drive cars themselves.</p> <p>Returning to the hotel, the group will prepare for dinner.</p>
